Code of Conduct – 2009-2010

Extra-curricular activities are an integral part of school life. They are an extension of the regular school program, but do not take precedence over subject matter areas.

Participants are expected to abide by all provisions of the Code of Conduct. The Code applies to all conduct associated with school attendance as well as to off-campus behavior when is judged to have an adverse effect on student discipline or the general welfare of the league. Any participant, or parent, whose conduct is judged to have violated the Code will be subject to appropriate disciplinary action as determined by the SRLA Board and coaching staff.

It is the responsibility of every player and parent to be familiar with the Code. The Code applies to conduct associated with all Scripps Ranch Lacrosse Association activities.

As a member of the Scripps Ranch Lacrosse Association, Players and family members will not:

- Use racially derogatory language
- Use abusive, inappropriate or vulgar language
- Use sexual nuances, actions or language
- Use tobacco, alcohol, illegal and non-prescription drugs, anabolic steroids or any substance to increase physical development or performance
- Knowingly jeopardize another player's health and/or well-being
- Show defiance towards coaches, referees or other support staff
- Deface practice or game field property
- Fight or commit any other physical assault
- Cheat
- Commit Arson
- Possess a dangerous weapon, or use an object to inflict bodily injury to another person
- Use, possess or sell explosive devices
- Use vehicles inappropriately on practice or game field property

As a member of the Scripps Ranch Lacrosse Association, players and family members will:

- Encourage all players to demonstrate sportsmanship to all teammates, opponents, officials, coaches, parents and fans
- Respect the integrity and judgment of the game officials, coaches and support staff
- Dress appropriately
- Be familiar with the rules of the contest
- Represent self and SRLA with self-control at all times
- Win with character and lose with dignity

As a member of the Scripps Ranch Lacrosse Association players will:

- Maintain at least a 2.0 GPA or equivalent
- Maintain good attendance and study habits

Any infraction of the Code will result in a phone call to the parents and:

First Offense: An offense by the player or family member will result in a one-game suspension.

Second Offense: A second offense by the player or family member will result in a one-week ejection.

Third Offense: A third offense by the player or family member will result in expulsion from the team.

Note: serious infractions could result in more serious action including immediate expulsion as determined by the SRLA Board and coaching staff.
